

The Sin Underneath the Sin Revelation 9

The fifth angel sounds his trumpet. (Revelation 9:1-12)

- Star = Angel
- **αβυσσος** = Abyss (bottomless pit)
 - Home of the Beast (Revelation 11:7; 17:8)
 - Satan's prison during the Millennium (Revelation 20:1-3)
 - Demons feared being cast into it. (Luke 8:31)
- Locusts (Revelation 9:3)
 - A symbol of destruction. (Psalm 78:46)
 - The power of scorpions.
 - Their war is with all who have not been sealed by God. (Revelation 9:4)
 - Their mission is to inflict pain and suffering for five months. (Revelation 9:5)
 - The severity of the pain is such that people will want to die. (Revelation 9:6)
 - Their Appearance (Revelation 9:7-10)
 - This horde of demons has a King. (Revelation 9:11-12)
 - "The Angel of the bottomless pit"
 - Abaddon (Hebrew)
 - Apollyon (Greek)
 - Destroyer (English)

The sixth angel sounds his trumpet. (Revelation 9:13-21)

- The Four Angels (Revelation 9:13-14)
- Two Hundred Million Demonic Beings (Revelation 9:15-16)
- Their Appearance (Revelation 9:17)
 - Breastplates the colors of fire, sapphire and sulfur.
 - Horses had heads of lions.
 - Horses breathed out fire, smoke and sulfur
- These beasts will kill a third of mankind. (Revelation 9:18-19)
- Commitment to Idolatry (Revelation 9:20-21)
